SDM Pakyong calls for quick landslide response

Pakyong SDM T. D. Denzongpa today called a follow-up meeting in his office today at Pachey regarding Saturday night landslides and road blockages caused by heavy rainfall in and around Pakyong Sub-Division.

The meeting was attended by sub-divisional officers RO/AD Kusal Gurung, SE Power and energy department, RO Forest Department, AE PMGSY, AE Irrigation, CDPO Pakyong, representative of HRDD, and DGM and AGM of Pakyong AAI and others.

During the meeting, SDM said due to hilly terrain and incessant rainfalls, there are chances of landslides and blockages of roads as the monsoon is on and he urged all presented departmental heads and AAI officials to be prompt to deliver action for clearing roads and



landslides, so that our ultimate goal to serve people be delivered at the best.

He ask cooperation from all the concerned departments engineers and staffs to be alert during this monsoon and also urged AAI officials to be alerted as most of time the surface rainwater blockages the road from Pakyong to Bhanu turning.

Meanwhile the road which was blocked from

Pakyong to Bhanu turning was clear last late night for traffic.

Pakyong AAI DGM Jagbhir Singh asks the cooperation of the Sub-Divisional and state authorities to acquire the land below nearby Airport Wall who have to suffer due to Airport construction and rainwater as the AAI is ready to pay for the damages.

We want the state government to process for

the acquiring of land who are suffering due to Airport.

We want to operate and inaugurate the Pakyong Airport as it is in the concluding stage and few works like stabilizing of uphill has to be redone at Airport site, he added.
